Beaver Creek Easter Egg Hunt Overview 2018

The Beaver Creek Easter Egg Hunt takes place on Saturday, March 31, 2018 beginning at 10:30am. The egg hunt is held at Creekside Park below the main Beaver Creek Plaza. The Egg hunt is free for kids and we do have egg bags for kids who need them. If you go to the Plaza side of the Beaver Creek Covered Bridge, you can follow the path down to Creekside Park along the Creek. The path to the event will also be dotted with balloons and signs.

We have 2 egg hunting zones:

• 4 & Under **Zone** - The first zone is for kids ages 4 & under. Parents can accompany their children into this zone. The kids and their parents line up in our cue. We place eggs in this zone, then we open the gate and let a certain amount of kids/parents into the zone. We only let a safe amount of kids into the zone at one time. The kids pick up all the eggs in the zone, we then ring the bell and that group of kids/parents leave the zone. We then re-seed the zone with eggs and let the next group of kids in. We repeat this process until we have gotten all the kids through the zone.

• Main Zone - The main zone is for kids ages 5 through 12 years old. Parents do not accompany their kids into this zone. The kids line up in our cue. We place eggs in the zone, then we open the gate and let a certain amount of kids into the zone (usually groups of 20-25). We only let a safe amount of kids into the zone at one time. The kids pick up all the eggs in the zone, then we ring the bell and that group of kids leave the zone. We then re-seed the zone with eggs and let the next group of kids in. We repeat this process until we have gotten all the kids through.

• **The Easter Bunny** - The Beaver Creek Easter Bunny is the Grand Marshall of the Beaver Creek Eggstravaganza Easter Egg Hunt. The Easter Bunny arrives at the beginning of the Easter Egg Hunt and helps with the Official countdown to start the hunt. He then moves to the Easter Bunny Hutch where he sits in a photo op area and waits for kids to come by to say hello and take a photo if they wish. Parents should bring a camera if they want a photo with the Easter Bunny. * The Beaver Creek Easter Bunny will also make an appearance at Beaver Creek SpringFest on Beaver Creek Plaza later in the day, between 3:30 and 5:30pm for photos with kids. Parents must bring a camera if they wish to get a photo with the Easter Bunny.
