






Ski Operations Schedule

Keystone encourages all guests staying within the resort to utilize our free, in-resort transportation system. Let us safely drive you to the slopes, activities and dining outlets. Shuttle stops are conveniently located close to most Keystone lodging accommodations, with service all village and base areas.

Insider's Tip: All vehicles traveling with families or four or more passengers may park for free every day of the season in any parking lot with availability, including paid parking lots.

River Run Village Parking

Parking is available in the River Run Condola lot, with front row priority to families and HOV's on a first-come, first-served basis. We encourage all guests to share a ride when making their way to the mountain! River Run is also home to two paid lots, the Cold Bug and Hunki Dori lots. Both provide an easy walk to mountain access and Village amenities for a per-day fee. Cuests dropping off skiers and riders may utilize I5-minute parking. Please note, overnight and oversized vehicle (trailers, RVs, etc) parking is not allowed in any River Run lots.

Mountain House Parking

Cuests accessing the mountain, Ski & Ride School and other amenities in the Mountain House base area can find parking on both the East and West sides. The East side offers paid parking (closest to the ticket office and mountain access). The West side of the base area also offers paid parking (closest to Ski & Ride School and Keystone Sports rental shop). A 15 minute skier drop off area is available on both the East and West sides of the Village as well. Please note, overnight parking is not allowed in any Mountain House lots.


Shuttle Lots
