#### SAMPLE ITINERARY OF 1 DAY ADVENTURE

8:00 Meet outside on the deck of Essentially Blackcomb, in the Carleton Lodge, in the main village between the gondolas.

8:30 Head up Whistler or Blackcomb with lift-line priority, then traverse out into Garibaldi Park.

9:30/10:30 If you're heading for a big objective, you'll be well on your way by now. Newcomers will be learning avalanche rescue and snow safety while navigating through the backcountry.

Rest of the Day Will be spent skiing incredible powder runs, and accomplishing all of the goals laid out for the day depending on your program.

This is a flexible itinerary; the snow and weather will call the shots. We're all about getting the goods while they're good, where they're good. If you are lost or late, please call our office at 604 938 9656.

#### WHO & WHEN

Advanced-intermediate to expert skiers and riders can enjoy Extremely Canadian Backcountry Adventures, regardless of your touring experience. Adventures run daily—subject to weather, avalanche conditions, and meeting the minimum group size.

All programs run from December 9, 2017–April 10, 2018. Private adventures operate from Opening date to Closing day. Discounted 'Backcountry' Lift Passes are available for \$62. This replaces a normal lift pass and is only available to participants. Adventures run subject to weather, avalanche conditions, and meeting minimum group size of 3 persons.
